1. Transportation information will be sent directly to the home via the Red Clay Transportation Department.
2. The Skyline Academic Day begins at 8: 02. Skyline will welcome students into the building starting at 7:50. Dismissal will begin @ 2:50.
3. Car line: Family members may enter the parking lot and disembark students at the upper level of the parking lot. The lower level is secured for bus transportation. Families may begin to drop students off for the academic day beginning at 7:45. Car riders and walkers arriving to school prior to the 7:50 time may wait under the covered area at the main entrance of the building.
4. Skyline falls within federal guidelines for all students to receive free breakfast and lunch.
5. 6th grade students first day of school is scheduled for Monday, August 29, 2022
6. 7th and 8th grade students will join our 6th grade students, Tuesday, August 30, 2022
7. All students will be provided a printed copy of their individual schedule the first day of school. Please note student may review schedule on line via Home Access starting Tuesday, August 23, 2022.
