1. I will act responsibly at all times in the classroom. I understand that horseplay, jokes, and pranks are not appropriate in a science classroom.
2. I will follow all instructions, written and verbal, about the laboratory procedures given by the teacher. 3. I will perform only those activities that have been authorized by the teacher. I will never do anything that is not called for by the procedure. I understand that unauthorized experiments are forbidden.
4. I will keep my table and the area around it clean and neat.
5. I will immediately notify the teacher of any emergency.
6. I will tie back long hair, baggy clothes, and dangling jewelry while doing a laboratory activity. 7. I know whom to contact for help in case of an emergency.
8. I will not take anything out of the classroom without permission from the teacher.
9. I will never eat, drink, or chew gum in the classroom unless instructed to do so by the teacher.
10. I will not use classroom equipment as containers for food or drink.
11. I will only handle living organisms when authorized to do so by the teacher.
12. I will not run with or use sharp objects inappropriately.
13. I will handle potentially hazardous materials with caution and gloves.
