Terry Casson-Ferguson is part of the healthcare team with ChristianaCare's School-Based Health Centers. Terry helps students and their families connect to services and resources. She also empowers them to advocate for themselves by providing education on life-planning, goal setting, and how to find resources in and outside the school.

Community Health Workers can help with:

- Scheduling and attending medical and non-medical appointments
- Connection to health insurance
- Connecting to community resources including food and clothing
- Home visits to check on wellbeing

Community Health Workers cannot help with:

- Paying for any of medication, or services.
- Giving medical advice or care.

Who is eligible?

- Students attending Warner Elementary
- Students who are Medicaid-eligible or uninsured
- And/or students who are:
 - Living with a chronic disease (e.g., asthma, diabetes)
 - Living with a cognitive disorder (e.g., ADHD)
 - Non-residents/Non-citizens
 - Currently without a primary care doctor
 - Currently without a recent physical
