**ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM**

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**SCIENCE SAFETY | 7001.4**

Providing a safe learning environment is an essential part of any performance-based, hands-on science lesson, whether in a kindergarten classroom or a high school chemistry laboratory. The Red Clay Consolidated School District Science Safety Manual for Schools has been prepared to help science teachers, administrators, and other school staff members understand and avoid situations in which accidents might occur in the science classroom or laboratory or during learning opportunities and experiences that take place outside the classroom.

The Red Clay Consolidated School District Science Safety Manual for Schools constitutes the district's science safety plan. All schools must adhere to the manual. All employees are responsible for knowledge of, and compliance with, the manual as well as their school/department-specific policies regarding school safety.

The Supervisor of Science will be responsible for maintaining and distributing the manual. The manual will be reviewed annually.

Science safety will be included in the district's annual safety training for all science teachers.

This administrative memorandum is intended to ensure compliance with 14 DE Admin Code § 885.
