

John Dickinson Rams Uniform Policy

The uniform policy is in effect from the beginning of the instructional day until school is dismissed for the day. Nothing prohibited by the RCCSD Dress Code is permitted by this policy. The discretion of the administration is preserved.

Golf / Polo-Style Shirts

- Any solid color, short- or long-sleeved polo shirt
 - Long-sleeved undershirt is permitted underneath, but must be white, gray, or black
- Solid-colored dress shirt; no more than two buttons undone
- Turtlenecks are considered a “collared shirt” and are permitted

Second Layers

- Lightweight and solid color
- Crewneck, V-neck or Cardigan
- Solid color polo **must** be worn underneath all second layers
- Cowl-neck sweaters (and high-neck sweaters) are permitted as a second layer, but students must wear a collared shirt under these garments
- **Only** Dickinson hoodies are permitted
- Suit jackets are permitted, provided the appropriate first layer is worn underneath
- Cold-weather jackets and coats must be stored in student’s locker
- Denim jackets are not permitted

General

- The uniform applies (in general) to students going on a field trip
- Dresses are not permitted
- Blankets are not permitted
- Denim jackets are not permitted
- Clothing must not be see-through
- At all times, the discretion of school administration is preserved

Khaki Pants / Shorts / Skirts

- Dockers, chino style, or cargo pants
 - Navy, khaki, black, olive green, or gray
- No jeans or corduroy material
- No leggings, yoga pants, sweat pants, joggers, or stretch-material pants
- Pants, shorts, and skirts must **not** have rips, holes, or tears
- All shorts and skirts must also be one of the approved colors: navy, khaki, black, olive green, or gray
 - Hem of garment must reach a point **no more than 4 inches** above the top of the knee
 - Skirts may not be stretch material
 - Tights may be worn underneath of skirts, but must be solid material (no holes)

Footwear

- Any sneaker, dress shoe, or boot with closed toe and heel
- No slides, flip-flops, slippers, or moccasins
- Sandals are permitted, provided they have a heel strap
- Turtlenecks are considered a “collared shirt” and are permitted

Dickinson Gear

- The definition of spirit wear will include t-shirts, which may only be worn as a second layer over a collared shirt
- Polo shirts and sweatshirts with Dickinson logo are always permitted
- Sweatpants, t-shirts, and other logo apparel are permitted only on specially designated days
- Team uniforms (tops only) and other team apparel—if provided through the team—are permitted at the discretion of the respective coaching staff
