Policy Statement

The Board is committed to developing policies that guide the District's programs and that recognize and address the critical issues in the District.

Proposals for new or revised policies may be initiated by any Board member or by the Superintendent. A proposal shall proceed as follows:

- Research and data assembly by district administration
- Board discussion may occur when a policy is proposed, first reading and/or second reading.
- Draft of the policy by the Board, administration, or an advisory committee
- Presentation of the policy for first reading at a public meeting, except in emergency situations
- Staff and public comment opportunity
- Second reading of the policy at a public meeting
- Formal adoption or rejection
- Dissemination, implementation, and enforcement

On a regular cycle, the Board shall review the policy manual and revise, reapprove, or eliminate policies.

Responsibility

The Superintendent shall be responsible for ensuring that all Board policies are implemented throughout the district. The Superintendent and his/her designees shall be responsible for developing procedures that support Board policy.
