Policy Statement

The Mission of the Red Clay Board of Education is to create a high quality, academically challenging, and dynamic educational experience for our diverse student population through meaningful community engagement, careful resource allocation, and thoughtful policy development.

The Mission of the District is to ensure that all students receive an education that will enable them to maximize their achievement and develop skills, knowledge, and experiences to prepare them to become productive members of society.

All students in the District are entitled to educational opportunities and instruction that meets their needs. All students shall be given instruction to help them learn to live with others, achieve and maintain sound mental and physical health, think logically and express themselves clearly, live in and respect their environment, prepare for work and/or post-secondary education, and use their leisure time well.

Schools shall help each student develop respect for the dignity and value of others and emphasize ethical values. They shall provide students with educational and vocational opportunities and develop in them a knowledge and appreciation of diverse careers and professions.

The curriculum of the schools shall be coordinated and shall be adjusted to the needs of the individual and the demands of society. Community resources shall be used to support instructional needs of students.
