Policy Statement

The Board is committed to the efficient use of energy while maintaining a comfortable and safe learning environment for students and staff.

The District shall develop and maintain an energy management program containing the following elements:

- Guidelines and procedures for best management practices in the daily operation of the District's facilities including behavioral strategies, lighting, temperature control, ventilation, peak demand control, and scheduling
- Procurement of energy at the lowest possible cost
- Accurate records of energy consumption and cost provided to building personnel on a regular basis
- Modifications and/or retrofitting of facilities to improve energy-saving
- Training on efficient energy usage
- Recognition of those who contribute to reduced energy usage

Responsibility

The Superintendent shall be responsible for compliance.
