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| Policy Statement | - The Board may, by majority vote, establish standing or special committees to assist in research or other well-defined activities in any area of Board responsibility. <br> - Specific topics for study or activity shall be assigned in writing to each committee immediately following its establishment. <br> - Committees shall be directed in the following areas: <br> - Length of time members shall serve <br> - Specific area of service <br> - Resources to be provided by the Board <br> - Relationship with the Board, individual Board members, Superintendent, and professional staff <br> - Upon completion of its assignment, each committee shall be dissolved or given a new task. <br> - Committees shall not continue to serve without definite assignments. <br> - The Board shall have sole power to dissolve any advisory committees except those formed through contractual agreement. <br> - The Superintendent shall maintain a list of citizens and staff members who have served on advisory committees, are currently serving, have expressed a willingness to serve, or who may be recommended for such service. <br> - When committee members are needed, they should be comprised of following groups: <br> - District administration (3) <br> - School leadership (3) <br> - Teachers ( 2 chosen by RCEA 1 by district) <br> - Parents and community members (1 per nominating district) <br> - If the district administration determines special expertise may be necessary; an outside expert may be appointed by the Superintendent. <br> - All appointments of citizens to advisory committees shall be made by the Board. <br> - All appointments of staff members to advisory committees shall me made by the Superintendent with Board approval. <br> - Board appointed committees must follow all regulations related to the State of Delaware open meeting law. <br> - The Citizen Financial Review Committee (CFRC) shall operate as (i) a Citizen Budget Oversight Committee of the Board consistent with 14 Del. C, § 1508 and 14 DE Admin Code§736; and (ii) a public body pursuant to 29 Del. C. Chapter 100 will have its membership determined by a Selection Committee appointed by the Superintendent and in accordance with Title 14, 736 |  |
