Safety

To help prevent the spread of germs, practice the following:

- Wash your hands often, using soap and water (for at least 20 seconds) or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol;
- Practice social distancing; only go out if you absolutely have to, 6 ft apart. People without symptoms can still spread the virus.
- Wear a face covering when going out in public.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces; Avoid handshakes for now; instead consider a friendly elbow bump.
