### **Policies Under Review:**

- The meeting was called to order by the chair. The committee approved the 10/4/23 meeting minutes.
- **Policy #4004** Drug and Alcohol Policy—Part of the negotiation with RCEA in 2014. The committee agreed during the 10/4/23 meeting to send this policy to district legal counsel and back to the committee for our review. Review of marijuana laws due to changes.
- **Policy #4022** Adult Sexual Misconduct Policy (New Policy)—Legislation that was sponsored by a number of legislators in the State of Delaware. Copied word for word from the State of Delaware.
- **Policy #5013** Attendance Zone Review—The committee paused at the 10/4/23 meeting to receive legal feedback from our legal counsel. The committee discussed the option to input a 10-year review of attendance zones as a recommendation of the board. The following sections have been removed from the policy **3D**: Demographic Consideration—factors such as student population density, socioeconomic status, racial and ethnic diversity, and other relevant demographic characteristics and **5C**: Demographic Equity: Promote diversity and prevent the concentration of students from disadvantaged backgrounds or specific demographic groups in a single school or attendance zone and include population density. During the 10/4/23 BPC meeting the committee agreed that the board would provide the scope of the review.

### **Committee Reports:**

- There is no public comment to be reviewed at this meeting. The committee discussed policy #4022—Adult Sexual Misconduct and confirmed that the districts social media policy includes procedures for adult sexual misconduct.

### **Committee Recommendations:**

- Policy #5013 Attendance Zone Review—Input a 10-year attendance zone review for equitable distribution of student population. The committee also recommends that the board provide the scope of the review.
